



Travel Support Scholarship Economics Department Winter 2020 or Spring 2020

The Department of Economics is excited to offer one Travel Support Scholarships (TVS hereafter) for students majoring in Economics who participate to an International Experience or Study Abroad program in the Winter 2020 (this winter-session) or Spring 2020. The Department will award a TVS of \$700 to support travel expenses. Students who are participating in a Faculty-led study abroad program are also encouraged to apply to the World Ready Scholarships offered by the College of Fine Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences. Other scholarships may be available from outside UMass Lowell. The TVS can be cumulated with any other support scholarship. The TVS can be used toward Study Abroad Programs led by UML faculties in or toward spending one or two full semesters abroad.
